Founded in 2009 in Amman, Jordan, naqsh is the joint endeavor of two sisters, nisreen and nermeen abu dail. 'naqsh' translated, means to 'engrave' which was the first form of lasting artwork that left a print by humanity. Tapping into their rich heritage and affording it new meaning, naqsh collective is at the crossroads between age-old Arab world design practices and a clean, contemporary aesthetic repositioning element of Middle Eastern art, architecture and heritage in a minimalist frame. Their delicately hand and fine machine finished artworks and sculptures coming together to create a new visual language conceived from crossing the architectural lines in Nisreen's realm with the graphical images in Nermeen's world, embodied in timeless material to last telling stories from their culture and heritage.

naqsh collective have exhibited extensively at exhibitions and events such as: Venice Design, Milan Design Week, Amman Design Week, Design Days Dubai, and Saudi Design Week and their works have been displayed in museums such as Victoria and Albert Museum in London, and other museums in Lebanon, Sharjah, and Palestine.

An architect inspired by the minimalist style of our contemporary life, she began her career in Jordan. Architecture as a discipline allowed her to observe and practice art and design. As an aspiring artist, she started creating personalized jewelry, art pieces, and furniture. Soon she began to exhibit her work at local art venues. Following her move to the USA, she continued to develop her career as an architect and an artist where she exhibited her artwork in several local and national art shows. Returning to Jordan in 2009, nisreen founded naqsh collective along with her sister nermeen abu dail and the journey began.
